5. Accommodation and meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner, morning and afternoon snacks) for 7 days will be charged to downloaded funds for DAP-ELLN. First meal will be dinner of Monday, February 26, 2018 and last meal will be afternoon snacks of Monday March 5, 2018.
