The Girl Scouts of the Philippines - Abra Council shall conduct the 42<sup>nd</sup> Provincial/Council-wide Camp and Coronation Rites of Miss Junior and Senior Scouts at **Nalnas, Langiden, Abra** on **January 30, 2018 to February 2, 2019** (Thursday-Sunday). We are expecting 1,000-1,500 Junior and Senior scout participants from the 28 districts and 25 high schools and some private schools.

**Camp Fee: P350.00 (girls and adults)**

(to cover program materials, administrative expenses, representation for the camp staff and resource persons for the whole duration of the event, trophies, plaques, badges, tokens for the guests of honor and speakers, prizes for the winners, souvenirs and stipends.)

**Registration: 7:30 am January 30, 2019 (Wednesday)**  
**Opening Ceremony: 8:00 am January 31, 2019 (Thursday)**  
**Closing Ceremony: 8:00 am February 2, 2019 (Saturday)**

**CAMPER'S QUALIFICATIONS:**

**Girl:**

1. She must be a registered Girl Scout.
2. She must have at least attended a Troop/District Camp.
3. She must have earned badges in the 8-Point Challenge.
4. She must be able to live by the GS Promise and Law.
5. She must be emotionally stable and physically fit.

**Adult:**

1. She must be a duly registered Troop Leader.
2. She must have directed or served as staff in the troop/district/provincial encampments.
3. She must be able to live by the GS Promise and Law.
4. She must be emotionally stable and physically fit.




**Camp staff** must be in the camp to assist in the arrival and settling down of campers.


Service credit shall be given to adult leaders in lieu of their services rendered on Saturday (February 2, 2019).

We hope for 100% participation of schools in your district. Thank you very much for your endless support. God bless and more power!


