**DIVISION TRAINING OF SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS ON CAMPUS JOURNALISM**

To: Public Schools District Supervisors  
Elementary and Secondary School Heads  
Elementary and Secondary School Paper Advisers

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section I, Rule IX of Republic Act 7079, also known as Campus Journalism Act of 1991, the Schools Division of Abra will conduct the Division Training of School Paper Advisers on Campus Journalism at the Division Conference Hall (Third Floor) on July 18-20, 2019.
2. The training aims to enhance the journalistic skills of campus paper advisers to be able to:
  - a. achieve competence in lay-outing, desktop publishing, radio broadcasting, news writing, feature writing, editorial writing, copy reading and headline writing, sports writing and science and health writing,
  - b. identify the school's weak areas in journalism and strengthen these through workshops,
  - c. formulate a set of criteria for the selection of participants/contestants in the different contest categories in the division level.
  - d. address issues and concerns relative to journalism through a healthy forum

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
