
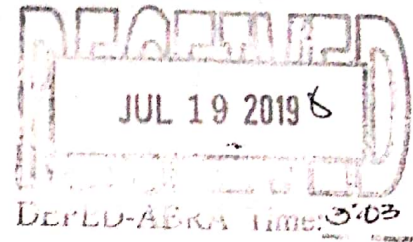

AUTHORED STORYBOOKS/SHORT STORIES, ESSAYS, AND FEATURES FOR MERITS- BASED
EVALUATION AND ASSESSMENT**

1. Cognizant to a more objective and efficient merits-based evaluation for promotion; Master Teachers, Teacher II, Teacher III, non-teaching personnel and School Heads can submit original/ authored materials to the Division LRMSD Section for quality assurance, pilot testing, certification for developers/authorship and publication at www.sdoabra.com.
2. For the certification of developers which will be credited as curriculum innovation (school head); introduction and utilization of curriculum or instructional materials (K-12 teachers), school heads and K-12 teachers can submit modules and activity sheets.
3. For the certification of authorship/publication, K-12 teachers and school heads can submit storybooks/short stories, essays, and features.
4. Non-teaching personnel can submit authored essays, features and short stories for publication /authorship or accomplishment.
5. The developers or authors are required to follow the full cycle of processes. See attached copy.
6. Dissemination of said memorandum is deemed necessary.
