CONDUCT OF LIMITED FACE-TO-FACE VALIDATION FOR SCHOOL-BASED MANAGEMENT (SBM) LEVEL OF PRACTICE

1. To ensure the strengthened implementation of School-Based Management amidst the COVID-19 pandemic, the Schools Division Office of Abra, through the SBM Task Force, will conduct a limited face-to-face validation of documents of schools under SBM Level 1 of Practice on September 29, 2021, Tuesday, September 30, 2021, Wednesday, and October 1, 2021, Friday, in front of SDO canteen.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. Validate documents presented by concerned schools through the conduct of limited face-to-face meeting;
 - b. Provide appropriate technical assistance to concerned schools in the implementation of School-Based Management and preparation of documents relative thereto; and
 - c. Continuously strengthen School-Based Management despite the extraordinary challenges brought by the pandemic.

 - b. Action Officer and PSDS of Baay-Licuan District;
 - c. School Heads and Teachers of Nalbuan Elementary School, Licuan Integrated School, Liwang Elementary School and Malibcong Elementary School; and
 - d. Concerned SBM Task Force.
