

**MECHANICS AND CRITERIA FOR THE CONTEST (Poster & Slogan Making for both Elem. & Sec.)**

1. Contestant shall be any learner enrolled in the public school for the current school year.
  - a) Elementary – any learner from Grade 4-6
  - b) Secondary – any learner from Grade 7-10
2. The Coach shall ensure stable internet in the area where the learner shall be doing his output. The learner will join the link for the break out session just right after the launching where he/she shall be the subject of the camera while doing his/her poster/slogan as the case may be. Technical team will be assigned to monitor that the learner is the one performing the task for the 3-hour duration.
3. Photo of the output shall be submitted to the link that will be provided on the day of the competition while the hard copy (final output) shall be submitted to the Records section immediately after the competition. Output shall be wrapped with Manila Paper and only the CODE that will be provided to the contestants/coaches shall be indicated outside the cover. For those who will have difficulty to submit on the same day, outputs are expected to be submitted on Dec. 1-2, 2021 at the records section since Nov. 30 is a holiday. Final judging of output and awarding shall be on Dec. 3, 2021
4. Materials that are allowed for poster and slogan making shall be the following:
  - a) 1/8 illustration board
  - b) Oil pastel
  - c) Pencil
  - d) Ruler
  - e) Pentel Pen
  - f) Eraser
5. Time Allotment for both Poster & Slogan Making shall be maximum of 3 hours.
6. Criteria for judging:

Creativity	- 25%
Originality	- 25 %
Visual Impact	<u>- 20%</u>
