MECHANICS OF THE DIFFERENT COMPETITION CATEGORIES IN THE 1ST VIRTUAL DIVISION **FESTIVAL OF TALENTS 2021**

A.

- The Coach shall ensure stable internet in the area where the learner shall be doing his output. The learner will join the link for the break out session just right after the launching and opening program where he/she shall be the subject of the camera while doing his/her Jingle Writing and Singing and Poster as the case may be. Technical team will be assigned to monitor that the learner is the one performing the task for the 3-hour duration.
- 2. Photo of the output shall be submitted to the link that will be provided on the day of the competition while the hard copy (final output) shall be submitted to the Records section immediately after the competition. Output shall be wrapped with Manila Paper and only the CODE that will be provided to the contestants/coaches shall be indicated outside the cover. For those who will have difficulty to submit on the same day, outputs are expected to be submitted on Dec. 1-2, 2021 at the records section since Nov. 30 is a holiday. Final judging of output and awarding shall be on Dec. 3, 2021.
- B. Jingle Writing and Singing (For Gr. 7 or 8)
- Contestants maybe represented by one who is enrolled in any level from Grade 7 or Grade 8.
- 2. The jingle must be original and not copied from any advertisement or program jingle/theme song.

3. Jingle should be written in Filipino.

4. Song Writer may choose any type of music genre (pop, rock, ballad, etc) for his/her competition.

5. Each participant will be given one (1) hour to compose the jingle based on the theme.

- 6. The contestant is allowed to use any instrument of his/her own choice to aid in song writing composition.
- 7. Song performance must not exceed 5 minutes including entrance and exit.

8. Performers should wear the school uniform for identity.

9. Performers during the said activity should observe netiquette and wait for their turn to perform

10. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable

- C. Poster Making Contest (For Grade 9 or Grade 10 and Grade 6 for the elementary)
 - 1. The elementary contestants are represented by one who is enrolled in Grade 6 level and the winner in their own district while secondary contestants maybe represented by one who is enrolled in any level form Grade 9 or Grade 10.
 - 2. Contestants should wear the school uniform for identity.
 - 3. The poster must be original.
 - 4. The school will provide the materials of their contestants (1/4 size illustration board, pencil and pastel/ craypas)
 - 5. Contestants are given three (3) hours' time allotment to finish their work
 - 6. Lettering and boarders are not allowed as part of the presentation
 - 7. A violation of the provision shall incur 5-point deduction from the general average of each judge.
 - 8. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.
