CONDUCT OF THE SALIN- KAHUSAYAN KAAGAPAY SA BRIGADA PAGBASA

1. the Department of Education through External Partnerships Service established the project "Brigada Pagbasa" as a form of Brigada Eskwela initiative which is an after- school reading program that envisions to bring together stakeholders to help all learners read and become functionally literate. The Schools Division of Abra contextualized the Brigada Pagbasa through the continuation of the conceptualized Salin Kahusayan, now Salin- Kahusayan Kaagapay sa Brigada Pagbasa Program (SKKBP) under the Bawat Bata Bumabasa program of the Department of Education and in coordination with the reading program of the Schools Division of Abra Bawat Batang Abrenio Bumabasa SDO Abra's Reading program "Bawat Batang Abrenio Bumabasa" and the Books on Wheels of the Learning Resource Management Services anchored from the SILNAG banner project in the context of partnership. This program aims to enhance the partnership engagements with stakeholders in the provision of reading resources and skills for the the Abrenio learners.
2. The implementation of Brigada Pagbasa will start with the call for volunteers from November 4- 9, 2021 using the template on enclosure No. 1 and for online registration this link is to be utilized. 3. Orientation of volunteers in the conduct of the Brigada Pagbasa will be on November 11- 12, 2021 at the 9: 00 AM on a virtual platform.
4. All schools are enjoined to support the activity and share updates on the implementation of the Program. All volunteer teacher applicants may be awarded with certificates for teaching experience corresponding to the duration of their service.
5. Meals and snacks during the orientation will be provided to resource persons, card load allowance will be given to volunteers and other expenses relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged to the partnership funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing.
