- 1. With reference to the MTB-MLE Operations Manual for Linguistcally Diverse Schools stipulating that one of the essential components of MTB-MLE is on Curriculum and Instruction which states that the language of instruction must be the language of assessment, the Schools Division Office of Abra will conduct the Sirib Ni Abrenio Division Pasalip Ti MTB 2021 to enhance beginning reading and literary skills of MTB-MLE learners with the theme: Dagiti Balligi Ni Ubing nga Abrenio iti Baet ti Pandemya. Conduct of this co-curricular activity will be on December 14, 2021via online platforms.(Links will be given to PSDS's)
- 2. This activity aims to
 - a. Track and measure the reading skills of beginning readers in MTB
 - b. Enhance literary skills of MTB-MLE learners through poem recitation in the Mother Tongue;
 - c. Appreciate and display love for reading through a slogan in the Mother tongue
 - d. Celebrate success of Abrenio learners amidst COVID-19 pandemic.
- 3. Ilokano language, being one of the 19 official languages will be used as medium for this year's competition.
- 4. The competition is open to all llokano speaking learners in the districts/ ICCs
- 5. Mother district champions will compete in the division level. Link for registration will be provided one week before the division level competition.
- 6. See enclosures for the mechanics of the different contested events.

MECHANICS AND CRITERIA FOR THE CONTEST

- A. Oral Reading with Comprehension- Grade 1
 - 1. There will be one (1) contestant per Mother district. A link will be given for all the contestants to enter one after the other. The coach shall ensure that the contestant has a strong and stable internet connection during the contest. The coach and the contestant will enter the given link upon call from the management with open audio and camera. It is reiterated that the contestant will use earphones. No coaching is allowed during the reading proper and the comprehension questions. Any unwanted commotions from other people except from the contestant will mean disqualification. The contestant will read the given text in the screen.
 - 2. There will be 5 Comprehension questions to be asked after the reading and the contestant is given 30 minutes to give the answer orally.
 - 3. Criteria for the oral reading with corresponding points
 - a. Clarity--- 10 points
 - b. Fluency- 10 points
 - c. Phrasing- 10 points
 - d. Accuracy- 10 points
 - e. Expression-10 points
 - 4.For the comprehension, every question is given 10 points, except for the last question with 20 points.
 - 5. The highest possible score is 100 which is the sum of the oral reading and Comprehension. The contestant with the highest score will be declared winner.

B. Poem Recitation-Grade 2

- There will be one participant per Mother district. A single piece is provided for the
 contestants. A link will be given to the contestants a day before the competition. Each contestant
 is given 5-7 minutes to deliver the poem. No props required.
 - 2. The criteria for poem recitation:

a)Mastery	30%
b) Expression	30%
c)Clarity	20%
d)Command of the language	20%
Total	100%

C. Slogan Writing- Grade 3

There will be one (1) contestant per mother district. The coach shall ensure that the
contestant has a strong and stable internet connection. Only the contestants will enter the link.
