

- 1. Pursuant to the mandates of RA 11510 otherwise known as Alternative Learning System institutionalization act of 2020. The Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) will lead the policy making body and gives direction to the massive implementation of ALS 2.0 with a theme ALS Level-up.
- 2. Anent to this, Curriculum Implementation Division Alternative Learning System Section slated a Division Quarterly Meeting of ALS Implementers to be held on March 10, 2022. - 5. Program Implementation Review reporting will be held during the activity in ten clustered districts following the herein attached template. Teamwork is encouraged in the preparation of the report to be reported by your representative who will do the presentation in 2-3 minutes using a power point presentation.
- 6. Meals and snacks will be served for the participants, while, venue rental and procurement of supplies are chargeable to FY 2021 downloaded PSF continuing fund subject to usual accounting rules and regulations.
- 7. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this memorandum is desired.
