2022 ONE HEALTH WEEK CELEBRATION

To: **Assistant Schools Division Superintendent**
Chief, Curriculum Implementation Division (CID)
Chief, School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD)

All Others Concerned

1. In reference to DepEd OUGFO Memo 2022-03-024 titled **Strengthening School Health Support for SY 2022-2023** and to DepEd Order No. 23 s. 201 titled **Policy and Guidelines on Oplan Kalusugan sa Department of Education**, the field is hereby enjoined to participate in this event to promote and highlight the DepEd's flagship programs under the Oplan Kalusugan sa DepEd (OK sa DepEd):

- a) School Based Feeding Program (SBFP)
- b) National Drug Education Program (NDEP)
- c) Adolescent Reproductive Health Education (ARH)
- d) School Mental Health
- e) Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) in Schools (WinS), and
- f) Medical, Dental, and Nursing Services.

2. The theme for the celebration is **"Pinalakas na Kalusugan sa DepEd, Pinalakas na Healthy Learning Institutions"**, emphasizing the implementation of Oplan Kalusugan sa DepEd flagship programs and to ensure that DepEd schools are **"health learning institutions, for the health, safety, and well-being of learners."**

3. Each day of the One Health Week will showcase sets of activities that shall focus on a specific OK sa DepEd flagship program.

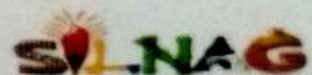
4. In this regard, all schools are directed to conduct the One Health Week either on November 2-4, 2022 or November 7-11, 2022. **It is emphasized that the Engaged Time-on-Task Policy of DepEd should be observed as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005.**

5. Relatively, as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 28, s. 2018, the School Head shall designate a Clinic Teacher/OKD Focal Person who will take the lead in the conduct and participation of the One Health Week activities.

6. Funding for the effective and sustainable implementation of One Health Week shall be charged from the school MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing policies, procedures and standards.



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7. The One Health Week shall be monitored by the SDO-Based School Health Personnel and shall provide necessary technical assistance to schools. Transportation, per diem and other incidental expenses shall be charged against the OKD Support Funds, SBFP Support Funds or Division MOOE subject to usual accounting and auditing procedures.
8. The activities shall be sustained throughout the school year, guided by the existing issuances per program and guidelines in the conduct of the activity.
9. A report and pictorials on the various activities during the One Health Week using the OKD Form A shall be submitted to the District School Nurse for consolidation and to be submitted to the SGOD – School Health Section on or before November 18, 2022.
10. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is directed.
