**POSTER MAKING CONTEST OF ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS
FOR THE 30TH NATIONAL CHILDREN'S MONTH CELEBRATION**

1. The Department of Education, joins the Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC), the National Youth Commission (NYC), the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) and all other stakeholders in celebrating the 30th National Children's Month (NCM), with the theme: *Kalusugan, Kaisipan, at Kapakanan ng Bawat Bata Ating Tutukan!*.
2. The National Children's Month (NCM) is annually celebrated every November pursuant to Republic Act 10661, entitled An Act Declaring the Month of November of Every Year as the National Children's Month, commemorating the adoption of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) on November 20, 1989, seeking to promote the protection of children's rights.
3. The objectives of the activity are:
 - a. To acknowledge the magnitude of the mental health concerns among children pre and during the COVID-19 Pandemic; and
 - b. To meet and improve of the mental health needs of Filipino children since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic through activities that responds to the categories of children's rights to survival, development, participation, and protection.
4. In line with the celebration, the Schools Division Office of Abra will conduct a poster making contest for Elementary and Secondary Schools.
5. The participants of this activity are Grades 4-6 of Elementary and Grades 7-12 of Secondary Schools. Only one (1) entry for the 10 Clustered Districts of Elementary and Secondary. For the Guidelines and Criteria, see attached Enclosure 1.
6. The prizes for the winners-Elementary and Secondary: 1st-3,000.00, 2nd-2,000.00, and 3rd-1,000.00.



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7. Prizes will be charged to the downloaded funds of Youth Formation, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. Deadline for submission of entries will be on or before November 29, 2022 at the Schools Division Office through the Public Schools District Supervisors of the 10 Clustered Districts. The entries will be judged on December 1, 2022 and announcement of winners will be done on December 5, 2022 during the SDO Flag Raising Ceremony.
9. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

POSTER-MAKING COMPETITION
Contest Guidelines

1. The participants of the competition are Grades 4-6 of Elementary and Grades 7-12 of Secondary Schools. Only one (1) entry for the 10 Clustered Districts.
2. The theme of the poster is **“Kalusugan, Kaisipan, at Kapakanan ng Bawat Bata Ating Tutukan!”**.
3. The poster should be created in $\frac{1}{4}$ **illustration board (15" x 20")**.
4. Poster should be original, handmade, painted or drawn, using any medium or mixed media.
5. The name of the learner, grade level, name of the school and district should be placed at the back of the poster.
6. Submit the poster entries to the Public Schools District Supervisor on or before **November 29, 2022**.
7. All qualified entries shall be judged by a board of judges that are experts in the field of arts.
8. Criteria for judging:
 - a. **Adherence to the theme - 30%**
 - b. **Creativity - 25%**
 - c. **Visual Impact - 25%**
 - d. **Composition - 20%**
9. The judges will select 3 winners from all the entries submitted and accorded the following recognition and prizes:
 - a. First Place - 3,000.00
 - b. Second Place - 2,000.00
 - c. Third Place - 1,000.00
10. The winners will be announced during the flag raising ceremony on **December 5, 2022**.



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
