**PARTICIPATION OF SDO ABRA IN THE CORDILLERA ADMINISTRATIVE REGION
 ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (CARAA) MEET 2023**

1. In reference to Regional Memorandum No. 179 s. 2023 dated April 12, 2023 entitled **2023 Cordillera Administrative Region Athletic Association (CARAA) Meet**, the Regional Office announces the conduct of Cordillera Administrative Regional Athletic Association Meet, to be hosted by the City of Baguio with the Schools Division of Baguio City on April 28 - May 1, 2023, with the theme *"Pagbubuklod Tungo sa Matatag, Maginhawa, Panatag at Makabatang Bansa"*. This year's conduct of the CARAA Meet and Palarong Pambansa is a modified version compared to previous years.

2. The departure of the participants from Bangued, Abra will be on April 27, 2023 at 1:00 pm in front of Abra High School, Bangued, Abra and the departure of the participants from Baguio City will be on May 2, 2023.

3. Relative to this event, the following are the activities to be undertaken:

4. Billeting schools for Abra delegation for the CARAA Meet proper is Rizal Elementary School and Rizal National High School, Pacdal Circle, Baguio City.

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5. All athletes, coaches, assistant coaches, chaperons, trainers, working committees and management board shall bring along with them their belongings like enough clothing, playing attires, sleeping kits, mattresses or beddings, pail, dipper, extra rubber shoes, drinking water container, toothbrush, toothpaste, bath soaps, laundry soaps, sanitary pads for girls, facemask, alcohol or hand sanitizer, and vaccination card, and other personal belongings. No one will be allowed to go home until the last day of the competition.
6. Meals and snacks shall be served on the duration of the CARAA Meet. Likewise, athletes shall be given delegation uniforms, caps, and playing attires, while members of the delegation including the committees will be provided with jackets chargeable to Special Education Fund.
7. School Heads are encouraged to provide the necessary support and assistance to the participating student-athletes and coaches from school MOOE or from other school-generated resources subject to usual accounting and auditing procedures.
8. Members of the delegation are advised to strictly adhere to the following policies for the duration of the meet:
 - a. Learners Rights and Protection Policy
 - b. No smoking, liquor and gambling policy
 - c. Clean, green and eco-friendly policy
 - d. No use of firewood policy
9. Curfew is set at 10 pm. Delegation officials, athletes, coaches, chaperons and trainers must be at their respective billeting centers on or before said time.
10. All athletes and other members of the delegation shall wear their ID cards at all times in a visible manner even outside their playing venues or billeting schools.
11. Public Schools District Supervisors/Principals/School Heads are enjoined to advice their teachers to give enough time for athletes who missed their academic classes in preparation for the CARAA Meet to complete all the requirements to enable them to pass their subjects.
12. The teacher-participants shall adhere to the policy on "No Disruption of Classes" as per DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2023 entitled "***Institutionalizing Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.***" School heads are expected to make necessary arrangements ensuring classes handled by involved teachers will be taken cared by other teachers.
13. Grades of athletes must not decrease due to their participation to sports activities representing their school/municipality/province (Education Act of 1982).
14. All athletes, coaches, assistant coaches, chaperons, trainers, working committees and management board shall secure an official travel authority. Travel expenses shall be charged against local funds or other available sources (SEF, MOOE)



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for Public School Participants, Private Sponsors if any) subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

15. Service credits/Compensatory Overtime Credits shall be granted to DepEd personnel for Saturday, Sunday, Holiday and overtime services rendered up to maximum of five days supported by F-48 signed by their respective chairpersons in connection with the conduct of the 2023 CARAA Meet.
