1. Super Typhoon (STY) EGAY has brought massive destruction to many parts of Northern and Central Luzon, and the education sector is not excluded. To support the response operations and immediate learning continuity of the affected schools in the Schools Division Office of Abra, a total of One Million Five Hundred Forty Thousand Pesos (1,540,000.00) from the Disaster Preparedness and Response Program shall be downloaded for clean-up and minor repairs amounting to Twenty-Thousand Pesos (20,000.00) for each of the affected schools.

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**ANNEX E.1: IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES OF THE FY 2023 DISASTER PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE PROGRAM FUNDS FOR CLEAN-UP AND MINOR REPAIR**

1. Affected school/s that meet any of the following criteria will receive funds amounting to P20,000 for clean-up and minor repairs:
  - a. School incurred a totally damaged classroom;
  - b. School incurred a partially major damaged classroom;
  - c. School incurred a minimum of 10 damaged school furniture;
  - d. School incurred a minimum of 100 damaged learning resources;
  - e. School incurred a minimum of 10 damaged DCP components; and
  - f. School with less than 10 damaged units of two (2) or more components of non-infrastructure items.
2. All damages meeting the criteria above must be indicated in the **Rapid Assessment of Damages Report (RADaR)** or Incident Report that has been submitted to the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS).
3. If a school did not incur any infrastructure and non-infrastructure damages but requires cleaning and clearing operations based on a rapid assessment conducted by the regional or division DRRM Team, the school can be provided with clean-up and minor repair funds. The Schools Division Superintendent must submit a signed official request certifying the need of the school. The Division DRRM Coordinator should submit this request to the DRRMS for approval, with a copy furnished to the Regional Director.
4. The downloaded funds may be utilized for the following activities:
  - a. Purchase of supplies, tools, materials, and equipment needed for cleaning and clearing operations and repair of minor damages in the school;
  - b. Payment for the labor services of non-DepEd personnel;
  - c. Provision of meals for volunteers involved in cleaning and clearing operations and repair of minor damages in the school; and
  - d. Other expenses related to the clean-up and minor repair of the school.
5. All tools and equipment purchased by the schools using the clean-up and minor repair fund must be properly accounted for, maintained, and safely stored in the school for future use.
