1. This is to announce the conduct of Division Training-Workshop on Contingency Planning on October Pursuant to the mandate of Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS) to capacitate all School Heads and School DRRM Coordinators, this Division will conduct a Psychological First Aid (PFA) Training for School Heads and School DRRM Coordinators on October 23-25, 2019 at **(to be identified)**.
2. The Training aims to orient School Heads and School DRRM Coordinators in the Standardized DRRM Training Modules and to equip/capacitate School Heads and School DRRM Coordinators in the exercise of their duties and responsibilities on DRRM/CCA, and EiE, including what to do before, during, and after a disaster or emergency.
3. Participants to said training workshop is listed in the enclosed attachment.
4. This will be a live-in three-day seminar-workshop to be conducted outside the province.. Board and Lodging of the participants, speakers and facilitators during the three- day training workshop shall be charged to Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service Support Funds, while their travel expenses shall be chargeable to their school MOOE/ Local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing procedures.
5. Registration and opening program will be on **Wednesday (October 23, 2019) @ 2:00 PM**, therefore all participants must be at the training venue at **1:00 o'clock in the afternoon for check-in**.
