MONITORING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM (SBFP) FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2020-2021 WITH STRICT COMPLIANCE TO DO NO. 14, S. 2020 ENTITLED "GUIDELINES ON THE REQUIRED HEALTH STANDARDS IN BASIC EDUCATION OFFICES AND SCHOOLS"

- 1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learners Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), shall implement the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) for undernourished among public school children.
- 2. The program primarily aims to improve the nutritional status of the beneficiaries by at least 70% at the end of the 60 feeding days and improve the learner's health and nutritional values and behaviour.
- 3. Anent to this, the Department of Education-Schools Division of Abra started the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP)-Nutritious Food Products last October 12, 2020. Distribution of Ready to Eat Ration-Nutritious Food Products to the households of all the beneficiaries is highly directed pursuant to DepEd Order No. 39, s. 2017 and DepEd Order No. 023, s. 2020 with strict compliance with DepEd Order No. 14, s. 2020.
- 4. The Division Technical Working Group (DTWG) and all the SGOD-School Health Personnel are directed to conduct strict monitoring during the implementation and actual spot checking on cash release to schools on SBFP Funds.
- 5. The School Head shall oversee the daily implementation of the feeding program including procurement, complementary activities, distribution of food packs, disbursement and liquidation of funds.
- Expenses relative to the activity shall be charged against SBFP Funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

6. Immediate and widest dissemination of this memorandum is highly desired
