

## FORMAT AND CONTENT OF AN ARTICLE

1. The article should be in MS Word format typed double space, using Arial font 11-point size, and using A4 paper size with 1-inch margin on all sides. It shall contain 5000 to 6000 words including quotations, headings, citations, footnotes, reference list, tables, and figure captions.

2. Presenting figures and tables

- a. The discussion precedes all tables and figures consequently.
- b. It must also be presented in standard form (e.g. Table 1, Figure 1.....)
- c. Tables and graphs must be presented in greyscale. Avoid using colors in lines and graphs.
- 3. Writing Numbers
  - a. Writing in words the number zero to nine, while number 10 and above in numerals.
- 4. Sequence of Contents

Title. The title should be informative and concise, without abbreviations, acronyms, and consisting of not more than 12 words.

Author/s. The author/s name/s is /are written (First Name, Middle Initial, Family Name), affiliation (school / office) and email address. The name of the lead researcher comes first in case of more than one author.

Abstract. The abstract should be written in a single paragraph, and not more than 250 words, summarizing the main points (rationale, research aim, methodology, salient findings, conclusion) of the manuscript. It should be followed by 3 — 5 keywords related to the study.

Introduction. The introduction should include the nature or rationale of the study, research objectives, related studies, and importance of the study.

Methodology. Methodology should give sufficient information regarding the design or approach of the research. This section should describe the participants, the data collection, data gathering tool, data analysis and ethical considerations employed in the study.

Results and Discussions. Results and corresponding discussions should be presented following the order of the research objectives through incorporating analysis of the results, implications, attribution or justifications, and corroborations. The results should be presented logically and in objective manner.

Conclusions and Recommendations. This section should present the authors inferences and insights on the findings of the study. It should also present the future direction of the study.

References. All in-text citations and references must follow the American Psychological Association Publication Manual (6\* Edition). Check that all references corresponds to the literature cited in the text. Only those that were cited in the text should be listed.
