

TOBACCO GRAPHIC HEALTH WARNING ASSESSMENT

Regardle Act No. 100-83 or the Graphic Health Warnings (GRW) Lowespecifically marshabes the Department of Education (Depical) to "use (the GrW)
templates to educate children on the ill-effects of tobacco and ensure that these
are included in extension audjects under the K-12 curriculum." This has been
