

- 1. Pursuant to Division Memorandum No. 194 s. 2022, the Schools Division of Abra enjoins all learners, teaching and non-teaching personnel, officials and other stakeholders, including parents, to participate in the activities related to the 2022 Nutrition Month Celebration. This year's theme is "New normal na nutrisyon, sama-samang gawan ng solusyon!" The theme calls for strengthened nutrition interventions and solidarity towards nutrition improvement as the country shifts towards living with the COVID-19 virus.
