

NATIONAL DISASTER RESILIENCE MONTH TREE-PLANTING AND TREE-CARING ACTIVITY

- 1. In observance of NATIONAL DISASTER RESILIENCE MONTH (NDRM) and in support to the government effort to mitigate climate change and global warming, the Schools Division of Abra in partnership with the Local Government Unit of Sallapadan, Abra and in collaboration with the Department Environmental and Natural Resources will conduct a tree planting activity that will be held on July 29, 2022, 8:00 o'clock in the morning of Friday, at Sallapadan Central School and Gangal Elementary School.
- 2. Elementary and Secondary Schools are also required to conduct Tree Planting Activity simultaneously in their respective schools. It is encouraged to plant endemic/native and fruit-bearing trees inside the school premises.
- 3. The Public Schools Division Supervisor, District DRRM Coordinators, School Heads and School DRRM Coordinators are enjoined to coordinate this activity with the Municipal Environmental and Natural Resources Officers and Barangay Officials for the provision of seedlings/saplings. Attached is a copy of the guidelines on the conduct of the tree planting activity for the information and guidance to all concerned.
- 4. Moreover, Tree-Caring Activity will be participated by the School Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Coordinators on August 5, 2022, 8:00 O'clock in the morning at Bonglo, Licuan-Baay. Below are the guidelines to be observed during the activity, to wit:
 - a. Replace dead seedlings with new ones;
 - b. Clean the surroundings of newly planted trees and weed or remove nuisance/unwanted bush/grass; and
 - c. Protect trees with tree guards if deemed necessary.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS/GUIDELINES ON THE TREE PLANTING ACTIVITY

1. Who will be involved?

- · Elementary and Secondary Schools, teachers, including ALS mobile teachers, non-teaching and selected SDO personnel
- Stakeholders/LGU/NGA/NGO/PTA and other partners

2. Where will planting materials be sourced from?

- · Schools may coordinate with the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Officers (MENRO) and Barangay for the provisions of seedlings/saplings.
- · Seedlings/saplings sourced out may be augmented by seedlings produced from the school.

3. Where will the trees be planted?

- Tree planting shall be done preferably in school sites to ensure 100% survival rate.
- Schools with no available spaces may donate the seedlings/sapling produced in their schools to other schools.

4. How many trees should each participant plant?

Each participant may plant at least 2 depending on the availability of planting materials and the area of the school.

5. When and where will accomplishment reports be submitted?


Schools are expected to submit a report using the attached Form on August 10, 2022.


