RE: CONDUCT OF PSYCHOLOGICAL FIRST AID TO SCHOOL PERSONNEL

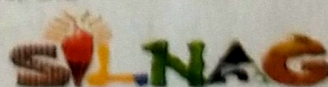

To further strengthen the role of parents and teachers as the education frontline amid disaster, the Department of Education (DepEd) is conducting a series of Psychosocial Support and Training for parents, teachers, school heads and identified DepEd schools. This is in line with the Department's goal in protecting and fulfilling the rights of a child anchored on the Convention on the Rights of Children especially in times where community quarantine is currently imposed in the country.
