**Advocating Abrenio Mangidaulo Banner Program in Support
to MATATAG AGENDA**

1. Consistent with the four Pillars of the DepEd MATATAG: *Bansang Makabata, Batang Makabansa*, the Youth Formation Section aligns its programs with Pillar **TA**: Take good care of learners by promoting learner well-being, inclusive education and positive learning environment.
2. Anchored also on the programs, projects, and activities of the DEDP, the School Governance Operations Division through the Youth Formation Section establishes the policy on the utilization of the Student Government Organizations Monitoring and Evaluation with Technical Assistance Form and YES-O Monitoring and Evaluation Form. All programs consistent to Youth Leadership activities, Pupil or Student Government PPAs will be under Abrenio Mangidaulo Banner program. *Mangidaulo* is an action word which means to Lead. It derives from the Ilokano Term *Daulo* or Leader.
3. This aims to;
 - promote the welfare of the Abrenio Learners by undertaking lawful measures for the protection and preservation of their rights.
 - develop responsible Abrenio Learner- leaders who will put educational opportunities to optimal use and look after the unity and welfare of their others in the school and community.
 - provide opportunities and venues for the Abrenio Learner-leaders to experience good governance, volunteerism, unity and cooperation; and improve their leadership knowledge, skills and attitudes.
 - train Abrenio Learner-leaders to become better members of society in accordance with the ideals and principles of participatory democracy and good citizenship.
 - participate with the School Staff in achieving their school's thrusts in improving learning outcomes through integrating Student Government Organization's PPAs with the Learning Recovery Plan, SIP/AIP, MATATAG Agenda and DEDP.
4. School Student Government Organization's Advisers or Coordinators with the assistance of the School Heads are instructed to update the physical requirements and evidences of the following indicators 2023 from March to April, 2023;
 - Indicator 1: Implementation of the mandated programs, projects, and activities
 - Indicator 2: Partnership and Linkages
 - Indicator 3: Embodiment of DepEd Core Values
 - Indicator 4: Good Practices
 - Indicator 5: Lead and Assist
5. The School Heads are tasked to conduct initial self-assessment based on actual compliance of their schools and submit the results to the School Governance Operations Division for the scheduling of validation.
