DIVISION TRAINING OF TRAINERS (DTOT) ON HIGHER ORDER THINKING SKILLS -PROFESSIONAL LEARNING PACKAGES (HOTS-PLP) FOR MATHEMATICS TEACHERS

To: Public School District Supervisors Secondary School Principals

- 1. DepEd SDO Abra is one with the department's initiative to recover learning loss. One the departments initiative is to capacitate teachers on the development of assessment items targeting higher order thinking skills using the Higher Order Thinking Skills Professional Learning Package (HOTS-PLP). This office through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will be conducting the Division Training of Trainers on HOTS-PLPS for Mathematics Teachers on Nov. 28 to Dec. 1, 2023 at Mt. Carmel Agri Tourism, Galicia, Pidigan, Abra.
- 2. The activity aims to do the following:
  - Develop guide materials intended for master teachers, school heads, and supervisors to support them in their mentoring roles in schools with a focus on helping teachers.
  - Provide proactive support to teachers in understanding HOTS and reflecting these skills in improving their respective classroom practices through the implementation/development of HOTS activities/items/questions for Mathematics.
  - Help teachers perform SOLO-based pedagogy and assessment strategies that promote the development of higher order thinking skills in Mathematics.
  - Provide the participants with opportunities to apply their skills in using the SOLO taxonomy.
