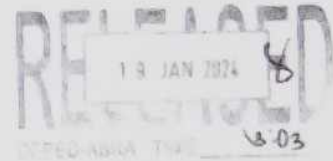

District Roll-out Training on the Upskilling of School Heads/Teachers on the Early Language, Literacy and Numeracy with Focus on the Science of Reading and Updates on School-Based Management

1. In support to D.O. No. 12, s. 2015 entitled- Guidelines on the Early Language, Literacy and Numeracy Program and in compliance to Division Memorandum No. 407, s. 2023 and Division Memorandum No. 364 s. 2023 on the conduct of Orientation on Principles, concepts and features of School-Based Management, Dolores Tayum- District shall conduct the District Roll-out Training on the Upskilling of School Heads and Teachers on the Early Language Literacy and Numeracy (ELLN) with Focus on the Science of Reading and Updates on School-Based Management on January 25, 29-30, 2024 at Dolores Central School, Dolores, Abra.
2. This training aims to:
 - a. Upskill teachers/school heads' capacity to use a knowledge-based pedagogy to become effective reading planners and update them on the principle, features, and concepts of SBM.
