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

RESUMPTION OF UPLOADING ACCOMPLISHED WinS MONITORING TOOL FOR SY 2022-2023 AND SY 2023-2024 VIA THE NEW E-OMS LINK

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

1. To ensure optimal learning outcomes and the health of learners, all schools must strictly adhere to a comprehensive, sustainable, and scalable school-based program promoting WinS. This program is fundamental in securing learners' rights to a protected environment conducive to their development.
2. The uploading of the Accomplished Wins Monitoring Tool for **SY 2022-2023** will resume from **February 1 to 15, 2024**. Subsequently, uploading for **SY 2023-2024** will occur from **February 20 to May 31, 2024**, using the latest E-OMS link: **<https://lis.deped.gov.ph>**.
3. For further instruction, download, print and review the WinS Enhanced OMS guidelines at **<http://tinyurl.com/WinSe-OMSResources>**.
4. Random school validation will be rigorously conducted by the School Nurses alongside the Division WinS TWG.
5. All School Heads are directed to exhaust all available means to elevate their respective school's **star status from zero to a minimum of 1 star**.
6. Furthermore, school heads must actively promote basic health and hygiene practices among learners. This includes mandating the use of personal water bottles, enforcing regular handwashing and toothbrushing using standard facilities (maintaining a ratio of 10 faucets to 1 handwashing facility), and ensuring the consistent sanitation of toilet facilities.
