Workshop on the Development of Contextualized Curriculum Guides for the Schools Located in the Different Indigenous Cultural Communities in Abra.

- 1. One of the four key aspects of the instructional design of the MATATAG curriculum is the CONTEXT, wherein the following are given primary considerations in developing the aforesaid curriculum (Learning Environment, Learners need relevance to real world situations, Cultural and Social factors, and Acquired Prior knowledge.) DepEd Order No. 62, S. 2011, otherwise known as ADOPTING THE INDIGENOUS PEOPLES (IP) EDUCATION POLICY FRAMEWORK stipulates that Recognizing Education as a necessary means to realize other human rights and fundamental freedoms, the DepEd urges the strengthening of its policy on IP education and develop and implement an IP Education Program, that subscribes to the rights-based curriculum, which gives primary importance to the principles of participation, inclusion, and empowerment. The realization of the Different Indigenous Cultural Communities (ICCs) in Abra, a Division-Workshop will be conducted on August 14-17, 2024, at West Loch Park Hotel, Sto. Domingo, Ilocos Sur.

  - formulate the standards as guides in the implementation of the unique curricula in the secondary schools located in the indigenous cultural communities.
  - draft the standars formulated for the indigenized curricula of the secondary schools in the indigenous cultural communities.
